# Mission Focus: Obria Medical Clinics Oregon

89% of pregnant women feel pressured to get an abortion. Pressured by...the father, parents, life circumstances, and our culture. This is WHY Obria Medical Clinics Oregon exists! Patients come in to Obria medical clinics scared to death because of this pressure. They feel alone and many times confused. Time, they feel, is their enemy. They can't

get it off their mind. In short, it is lonely and overwhelming.

We have a proven method of helping women who feel this pressure:

- 1) Show them the baby in their womb, and let them bond with the baby.
- 2) Help them slow down and "think out" their decision. Remove the panic.
- 3) Stand by their side and provide alternatives.
- 4) Most of all, let them know how much we care.

In addition, in 2021 we have <u>already</u> helped a woman get out of sex trafficking; helped a couple of women who are addicted to drugs get help; are helping a woman make the choice of adoption; have been discipling a woman who has started going to church; and are helping many overcome the pressure to abort so that they choose LIFE. Not to mention the hours of parenting classes we offer, the one-on-one and referrals our great staff offers, and the many other medical services we have provided our patients.

We believe that EVERY woman deserves the right to have someone help her when she is making this critical decision...Someone THAT WON'T BENEFIT FROM WHAT SHE DECIDES. In other words, to help remove the pressure so that she can make a positive decision for her and her baby.
