Shyam and Paula Khatri Bangkok, Thailand

Greetings from Bangkok, Thailand. Thank you for your prayers and support. Our family is doing well and praying that you are well also. Here is an update on the ministries.

# **Rajendra and Esther Church Planting Focus:**



Rajendra and his family are missionaries to Baitadi, a far west region of Nepal. They have faithfully labored for the Lord over ten years now. Last year they had to move back to Kathmandu because of severe health issues both Rajendra and Esther went through. It seems like they will have to stay in the city as they monitor their health. Their three

children are adjusting to their new school.

About two years ago, the Lord led Rajendra and Esther to start building a church building for the growing church plant that they were part of. As the COVID 19

issue arose, some of the supporters that had intended to help with finishing the building could not provide for them. As a result, the church building sits there unfinished. Rajendra says that another \$5,000 could help them finish the rest of the building. It needs doors, windows, finishing walls and floor, and electrical work. Would you prayerfully consider giving toward this project?
